The Ministry for Foreign Affairs presents its compliments to the Diplomatic Missions, Career Consular Posts and Offices of International Organisations in Sweden and has the honour to communicate the following minor changes in the routines for embassy security matters.

When representatives of Diplomatic Missions, Consular Posts or Offices of International Organisations wish to report a security matter not requiring immediate action they are henceforth invited to proceed as follows. A request for security measures should then be reported directly, in English or Swedish to the Stockholm County Police Command Centre (Länskommunikationscentralen) and a copy of the report sent to the Embassy Section of the Stockholm County Police's Operations Division. In the event of specific threats or violations, a copy of the report should also be sent to the Protocol Department of the Ministry for Foreign Affairs.

The chapter on embassy security in the Diplomatic Guide ([www.sweden.gov.se/mfa/cd](http://www.sweden.gov.se/mfa/cd)) has been revised accordingly. A copy of the new chapter is attached to this Note.

Furthermore, an updated list of useful telephone numbers to the Stockholm County Police, including the Embassy Section, is also enclosed.
